A single workweek is used in computing the wage due workers. No overtime. Employer will reimburse workers for all inbound transportation and daily subsistence costs paid by the workers from the place from which the worker has come to the place of employment, provided the worker completes fifty (50%) percent of the period covered by this job order. Upon completion of the work contract, employer will pay reasonable costs of return transportation and subsistence to the place of recruitment, except when the worker will not be returning to the place of recruitment, due to subsequent employment with another employer who agrees to pay such cost, in which case this employer will only pay for the transportation to the next job. The amount of outbound transportation payment will be equal to the most economical and reasonable similar common carrier transportation charges for the distances involved.
