Description:

The truss assembler will work with metal and wood trusses, produce trusses, parts or components for trusses depending on the size and measurements of projects, assemble pre-cut materials, accuracy of assembly, using ruler and gauges, fitting parts together, place metal reinforcement plates over connecting joints and connects parts at joints, may produce or help produce components according to instructions, use hand tools and machines used to build trusses are, but not limited to: hammers, saws, cutting saws, press breaks, jigs and clamps to hold members in place for assembly, laser cutter for precise component cutting, may use lifters for heavy trusses for roof trusses in building construction.

May be responsible for pulling plates, stacking of finished product, banding, and marking materials, and pushing products into position by hand or crane on carts to appropriate work area or storing them at the end of the workday to keep the area clean and free of hazardous pieces.

Three months of experience as truss assembler in residential or commercial construction settings. Must bend, lift, and sustain up to 50 lbs., work under extreme hot weather conditions. Travel will be required within several counties, no on-the-job training available, no education required. Post-hire drug test required paid by employer, all US and Guest workers will be screened equally.

20 H-2B temporary full time position workers needed to work from October 1 to November 15, 2026. Monday to Friday 7:00 am to 3:00 pm.

Wage paid \$33.11 per hour. If overtime is needed will be paid \$49.67 per hour.

A single work week used for computing wages. Payment will be weekly. Deductions to paycheck required by law and may include shared group rental housing of \$70 to \$75 per week depending on housing location, and a refundable security deposit of \$75; \$30 per week company-provided transportation to and from housing if worker wants company housing and/or transport, and it is available. Housing, if provided, will be in the Metropolitan area.

No mass transit to work sites. If the worker completes 50% of the work contract period, employer will reimburse the worker for transportation and subsistence from the place of recruitment to the place of work. Upon completion of the work contract or where the worker is dismissed earlier, employer will provide or pay for worker's reasonable costs of return transportation and subsistence back home or to the place the worker originally departed to work, except where the worker will not return due to subsequent employment with another employer. The amount of transportation payment or reimbursement will be equal to the most economical and reasonable common carrier for the distances involved. Daily subsistence will be provided at a rate of \$16.78 per day during travel to a maximum of \$68.00 per day with receipts, according to 655.20(j)(1)(i), (ii). These payments will be made with a company check, separately from their payroll check. The worker will be reimbursed for all visas, visa processing, border crossing, and other related fees, including those mandated by the government on the first work week. All tools, supplies and equipment required will be provided without charge or deposit charge according to 655.20(k). Workers must present themselves to the primary work site at 4542 Soundside Dr, Gulf Breeze, FL 32563, and then they will be sent off to unknown multiple work sites within Escambia and Okaloosa Counties. Transportation and housing required to work will be at company's expenses.
