The employer will use a single workweek to compute wages due. All deductions from the worker's paycheck required by law will be made. The worker's will be paid on a weekly basis. The employer will provide workers at no charge, all tools, supplies, and equipment required to perform the job.

H-2B workers will be reimbursed in the first workweek for all visas, visa processing, border crossing, and other related fees, including those mandated by the government (excluding passport fees). Transportation (including meals and, to the extent necessary, lodging) to the place of employment will be provided, or it's cost to workers reimbursed if the worker completes half the employment period. Housing at the worksite may be available with no payroll deduction. If the worker completes 50% of the work contract period, employer will arrange and pay directly for transportation and subsistence from the place of recruitment to the place of work. Upon completion of the work contract, or where the worker is dismissed earlier, employer will provide or pay the worker's reasonable costs of return transportation and subsistence back home or to the place the worker originally departed to work, except where the worker will not return due to subsequent employment with another employer. The amount for daily subsistence will be at least \$16.28 per day during travel to a maximum of \$68.00 per day with receipts. The amount of transportation payment or reimbursement will be equal to the most economical and reasonable common carrier for the distances involved.
