Description: Employer: Westbank Fishing LLC., 650 Poydras Street, Suite 2320, New Orleans, LA 70130, (504) 620-4404, ext 210. Job opportunity is temporary and full-time. 25 job openings. Duties: Perform maritime welding for maintenance, repair and upgrade of fishing vessels. Required experience is 12 months as a First Class Welder. Must pass employer's test of general maritime welding. Hours: 7:00 am to 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Job to begin 10/19/2026 and end 05/15/2027. Worksite in Empire, LA. Wage rate: \$31.43 to \$33.43/hour. Possible overtime at \$47.15 to \$50.15/hour. A single workweek will be used to compute wages due. Frequency of pay is every two weeks. Employer will provide optional on-site housing for the worker free of charge. Employer provides one meal per workday (lunch) free of charge. Employer will make all deductions from the worker's paycheck required by law. Employer provides optional advances to each worker \$150 upon arrival for the worker to buy groceries and personal hygiene products from stores in the area, and employer deducts \$75 from the first two paychecks. After completing half the employment period, employer allows advances on future paychecks, on a discretionary basis and up to a limit of \$1,000 with some exceptions for family emergencies, and only where enough workdays remain to cover the advance through equivalent paycheck deductions. Employer offers health insurance and 401(k). Workers who elect health insurance or 401(k) will have corresponding deductions from paychecks. H-2B workers will be reimbursed in the first workweek for all visa, visa processing, border crossing, and other related fees, including those mandated by the government (excluding passport fees). Employer will reimburse the worker upon arrival for transportation, which is based upon bus fare from the point of origin. Employer will also reimburse the worker any daily subsistence (including meals and, to the extent necessary, lodging) to the place of employment, if the worker completes half the employment period. Return transportation and subsistence will be provided if the worker completes the employment period or is dismissed early by the employer. The amount of daily subsistence will be at least \$16.78 per day during travel to a maximum of \$68.00 per day with receipts. The employer will provide workers at no charge all tools, supplies, and equipment required to perform the job. The employer guarantees to offer work for hours equal to at least three-fourths of the workdays in each 12-week period of the total employment period.
