This job order is being placed in connection with a future filing for H-2B labor certification.

Transportation and Subsistence: If the worker completes 50% of the work contract period, the employer will reimburse the worker for reasonable transportation and subsistence costs (including meals and, if necessary, lodging) from the place of recruitment to the place of employment. Upon completing the contract or if dismissed early, the employer will pay for return transportation and subsistence to the worker's home or the place the worker originally departed to work, unless the worker voluntarily abandons employment or obtains subsequent employment with another employer. Reimbursement will be equivalent to the most economical and reasonable common carrier for the distances involved.
