Sugar Bowl Corporation d/b/a Sugar Bowl Resort, located in Norden, California, seeks twenty (20) full-time, temporary Chefs who will be responsible for preparing, seasoning, and cooking soups, meats, vegetables, desserts, and other food items in a restaurant. The Chefs will be responsible for preparing and cooking food while delivering exceptional service to our internal and external guests. The Chefs are also responsible for performing a full range of the most difficult cooking tasks in addition to plating complex menu items and preparing sauces & soups. The Chefs will be responsible for not only the sanitation of their own station, but the full kitchen as well. The Chefs may also assist with ordering, inventory management and kitchen sanitation audits. Follows all grooming guidelines, is a role model for the rest of staff. Reads, understands, and follows recipes and station standards, strong knife skills required. Must be able to understand and help to enforce all applicable sanitation and food safety guidelines set by state and government. Helps to inspect food preparation and serving areas to ensure observance of safety and sanitary food handling practices. Able to execute the following skills to a high standard; sauté, grill, broil, bake, poach, fry, and braise. Must be able to lift and carry up to 50 pounds.

Will report directly to the Executive Chef and Food & Beverage Director at Sugar Bowl Resort.

Six (6) months of culinary experience in a fine-dining or high-volume environment at a high-end restaurant, resort, or private club with a fast-paced environment required.

Applicant must complete pre-employment background check at employer's expense.

Travel is not required.

Daily transportation to and from worksite is not provided.

On-the-job training is provided.

Wage: \$20.80 - \$31.00 per hour, paid bi-weekly. Overtime is available at \$31.20 - \$46.50 per hour.

Schedule: 40 hours per week. Work schedule can vary and can include evening, weekend, and holiday hours. Work may be performed on any day of the week from Monday through Sunday. Example shifts: 6:00am - 2:00pm, 8:00am - 4:00 pm, or 2:00pm - 10:00pm. Shift hours may vary.

A single workweek will be used to compute wages due.

Optional housing is offered on a first-come, first-serve basis for workers who are relocating to begin employment. Cost of housing, if accepted, is \$375.00 - \$700.00 per month (utilities included); rate varies by room type and occupancy. If used, total cost of housing will be deducted in installments of \$187.50 - \$350.00 (equal to one pay period's license fee or half the monthly rate) from the first two paychecks of each month. A refundable security deposit of \$187.50 - \$350.00 (equal to one pay period's license fee or half the monthly rate) is required, to be paid directly to employer upon acceptance of housing. Security deposit will be refunded depending on the housing's condition.

Additional optional benefits may be offered to worker, for worker's sole benefit, including employer- sponsored 401k plan and paid sick time. Workers become eligible for the 401k plan after 1,000 hours worked and one (1) year of employment.

All deductions from paycheck required by law will be made.

If the worker completes 50% of the work contract period, employer will pay directly for and/or reimburse workers for transportation and subsistence from the place of recruitment to the place of work. Upon completion of the work contract or where the worker is dismissed earlier, employer will provide or pay for worker's reasonable costs of return transportation and subsistence back home or to the place the worker originally departed to work, except where the worker will not return due to subsequent employment with another employer. The employer will pay directly for and/or reimburse workers for all reasonable inbound transportation and subsistence costs within the first workweek. The employer will pay directly for and/or reimburse workers for all reasonable outbound transportation and subsistence costs during the last workweek. The amount of transportation payment or reimbursement will be equal to the most economical and reasonable common carrier for the

distances involved. Daily subsistence will be provided at a rate of \$16.78 per day during travel to a maximum of \$68.00 per day with receipts.

The employer guarantees to offer work for hours equal to at least three fourths of the workdays in each 12-week period of the total employment period.

The employer will provide workers at no charge all tools, supplies, and equipment required to perform the job.
