BVR, LLC d/b/a Bolton Valley Resort, located in Bolton Valley, Vermont, seeks six (6) full-time, temporary Line Cooks who will be responsible for preparing, seasoning, and cooking soups, meats, vegetables, desserts, and other food items in a restaurant.

Will report directly to the Food and Beverage Director at Bolton Valley Resort.

Six (6) months of culinary experience in a high-volume environment at a high-end restaurant, resort, or private club required.

Travel is not required.

Daily transportation to and from worksite is not provided.

On-the-job training is provided.

Wage: \$21.29 per hour, paid weekly. Overtime is available at \$31.94 per hour.

Schedule: 35 hours per week. Work schedule can vary and can include evening, weekend, and holiday hours. Work may be performed on any day of the week from Monday through Sunday. Example shifts: 10:30am to 5:30pm, 2:30pm to 9:30pm, or 7:00am to 2:00pm. Shift hours may vary.

A single workweek will be used to compute wages due.

Optional housing is offered on a first-come, first-served basis for workers who are relocating to begin employment. The cost of shared housing, including utilities, is \$136.00 per week. Employees who accept housing will use RentRedi, a mobile app that allows tenants to manage their lease, make weekly rent payments, and set up automatic payments if desired. Rent payments will no longer be deducted from employees' paychecks and must instead be made through the RentRedi platform. A \$200.00 refundable security deposit is required and must be paid directly to the employer upon acceptance of housing.

All deductions from paycheck required by law will be made.

If the worker completes 50% of the work contract period, employer will pay directly for and/or reimburse workers for transportation and subsistence from the place of recruitment to the place of work. Upon completion of the work contract or where the worker is dismissed earlier, employer will provide or pay for worker's reasonable costs of return transportation and subsistence back home or to the place the worker originally departed to work, except where the worker will not return due to subsequent employment with another employer. The employer will pay directly for and/or reimburse workers for all reasonable inbound transportation and subsistence costs within the first workweek. The employer will pay directly for and/or reimburse workers for all reasonable outbound transportation and subsistence costs during the last workweek. The amount of transportation payment or reimbursement will be equal to the most economical and reasonable common carrier for the distances involved. Daily subsistence will be provided at a rate of \$16.78 per day during travel to a

maximum of \$68.00 per day with receipts.

The employer guarantees to offer work for hours equal to at least three fourths of the workdays in each 12-week period of the total employment period.

The employer will provide workers at no charge all tools, supplies, and equipment required to perform the job.

H-2B workers will be reimbursed in the first workweek for all visa, visa processing, border crossing, and other related fees, including those mandated by government (excluding passport fees).
