Ocean Gold Seafoods, Inc. is looking to hire 80 full-time, temporary, Seafood Processors from 12/1/2026 - 03/01/2027 at there worksite located at 1804 N Nyhus St, Westport, WA 98595. Phone: (360)268-2510.

Job Duties: Workers will process crab, multiple species of finfish, bottom fish and salmon. Work on the hand butcher line will involve use of hand and hand tools to perform routine cutting and trimming. Workers will wash, size, and grade seafood and then load processed seafood onto freezer baskets or cartons for shipping.

Employer is offering at least 35 hours per week, Mon-Sun, 7:00am - 7:00pm or 7:00pm to 7:00am, paid at a rate of \$18.87/hr. Employer is offering up to 32 hours of overtime per week, as needed, but not guaranteed. Overtime will be paid at a rate of \$28.31/hr for working greater than 8 hours in any day, or 40 hours in any week. Days and shifts may vary. Holidays, weekends, and evenings required as needed. Employer reserves the right to pay a

higher wage, rate, or bonus to any worker in their sole discretion based on skill, tenure, performance, or experience. Employer is offering paid on the job training.

Job Requirements: No education, experience, or training required. Lifting 50lbs regularly, working outdoors, working in freezer, pushing, pulling, standing.

Transportation: If the worker completes 50% of the work contract period, the employer will reimburse the worker for transportation and subsistence from the place of recruitment to the place of work. Upon completion of the work contractor where the worker is dismissed earlier, the employer will provide or pay for worker's reasonable costs of return transportation and subsistence back home or to the place the worker originally departed to work, except where the worker will not return due to subsequent employment with another employer or where the employer has appropriately reported a worker's voluntary abandonment of employment. The amount of transportation payment or reimbursement will be equal to the most economical and reasonable common carrier for the distances involved. Daily subsistence will be provided at a rate of \$16.78 per day during travel to a maximum of \$68.00 a day with receipts. The employer will provide transportation to and from worksite at no cost to workers.

Tools, supplies and equipment: Employer will provide workers at no charge all tools, supplies, and equipment required to perform the job.

Other Employment Guarantees: A single work week will be used for computing wages due and workers will be paid every 2 weeks. The employer will make all payroll deductions required by law and will not make any deductions, which are not required by law. If an employee chooses to live in optional employer housing \$100/week will be payroll deducted for housing expenses. H-2B workers will be reimbursed in the first work week for all visa, visa processing, border crossing and other related fees including those mandated by the government (excluding passport fees), incurred by the H-2B worker.

Housing: Optional employer housing is available at a cost of \$100/week.
